

Port Gamble Bay Cleanup CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

For your safety, the site is closed to the public but can be observed from the Port Gamble bluff. Please do not enter the construction site or approach equipment on the water at any time, whether you observe activity or not. Construction sites and equipment are inherently dangerous; please observe from a safe distance.

We are nearing the finish of our 2 year in-water construction project! We expect to complete the in-water work on January 14th and have obtained a 1 week permit extension to be on the safe side. We will work night and weekend shifts through the remainder of the project as most of the shoreline work needs to occur during the night time low tides. We apologize to our neighbors for any disturbance this noise causes.

We continue to import large amounts of clean capping materials. Capping operations continue in areas north of the mill site. *Please be aware of increased truck traffic in town!*

Ongoing water quality monitoring has shown no turbidity exceedances this season.

Some key planned actions during the next few weeks include:

- Importing of clean cap materials.
- Low-tide nighttime capping and placement of armoring rock.
- Demolition of the conveyor and log transfer dock (former ferry dock).
- Starting demobilization of the construction site and departure of construction equipment and barges.
